#### DISCUSSION:

- 1) Read 1 Peter 2:9. Describe what it means to be a:
  - a. Chosen race
  - b. Royal priesthood
  - c. Holy nation
  - d. People for His possession

2) When life is challenging, how does it help you to remember that you have been made all of those things through Jesus?

3) Discuss the statement: "Jesus drank the cup of wrath without mercy so that we can drink the cup of mercy without wrath." What does it mean to you personally that Jesus paid your sin debt?

4) What does it mean to be a child of God and a "royal heir?" How should our thinking and behavior be different if we really embrace our position in Christ?

5) If "living victorious doesn't mean living undefeated", what does victorious Christian living look like?

6) The next time that you are overwhelmed or discouraged, how will the truth of being God's child help you?

#### DIG DEEPER:

1) In I Peter 2:6-10, Peter quotes from Isaiah, Psalms, Exodus, and even Deuteronomy. Look up these cross references and consider why he is referring back to these Old Testament passages.

2) Study Galatians 3:23-4:7. How is this passage similar to the Scripture verses used during this message? How does it encourage you?
