

Think It Over: This section is about turning what God is saying to you into action steps. These talking points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you take your own next step. If you are leading a group through this guide, don't feel like you have to answer every question. Pick out those questions that will stir up conversation and action among your group.

- How have you seen the three ➤ *How do you see kids?* views in action? How do they go too far? How can they be blended in what turns out to be negative or positive?
- Have you had any experiences with being mentored or disciplined? What did it consist of? What do you believe is crucial for discipleship to have an effect? Which has changed you more - being disciplined or being a discipler?
- Read Mark 10:13-16. List all the people in the account. Describe how each felt and why you think they felt that way. When have you felt that way?
- Review the message guide outline. What resonated with you? Any new concepts? What known ideas were reinforced?
- Do you ever see the kids in your life as disruptions? If so, how? What are they 'disrupting' in your mind? What does the way you see them say about the way you see yourself?
- Have you ever treated the kids in your life as demigods? If so, how? Why is it easy for kids to become 'little gods' in your mind?
- Do you truly see the kids in your life as disciples? What are you doing to disciple them to Jesus? Are you doing something to disciple them to someone or something other than Him?
- Read John 3:30 from the message guide. How do John the Baptist's words make you feel when applied to parenting and influencing kids? What was John's goal? How do you think you can go about this as a parent or a person who influences kids? How does Ephesians 6:4 MSG clarify how we are to influence kids?
- Review the *Am I Making Following Jesus Attractive?* questions. What are your answers and how could they become more of a reality in your life?

Next Steps: What actionable steps could you take to make the truth in the bottom line more a part of your everyday life?
