Think It Over: This section is about turning what God is saying to you into action steps. These talking points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you take your own next step. If you are leading a group through this guide, don't feel like you have to answer every question. Pick out those questions that will stir up conversation and action among your group.

- Describe some marriages that are just plan awesome. What do you think makes them that way? What happens in a marriage where the wife doesn't allow the husband to lead like Jesus and the husband doesn't love his wife like Jesus loves the church?
- What do you think about the statement beginning with "In every society that has moved..."? Explain your thoughts and evidence for them? Why is that this not often accepted as true today? What will change that?
- What is your first reaction when you hear the word submit? Read Ephesians 5:21. What do you think it means to submit? What is the hardest thing about submitting to someone else? What are some negative responses people have to the idea of submission? Review the "Households" section. What stands out to you? Why is Ephesians 5:26 MSG important to the discussion?
- Read Ephesians 5:22-25. How is submission in a relationship, especially in the context of marriage, an invitation for someone to lead? Do you believe inspired Paul is clearly calling husbands to a scared duty to lead as Jesus leads the church? Why is trust crucial?
- Read Colossians 3:18 MSG. How is submission not the same as obedience? How have you seen Gary Thomas' quote to be true in life?
- ➢ Review and respond to each of the Submission ✓s. What are your takeaways? Which are the hardest for you and the easiest for you?

<u>Next Steps</u>: Review the Bottom Line. How is it reflected in your marriage and/or overall life (in relationships in general it is about knowing the other person)? What are some steps that you could take to move towards the ideal rather than giving up? What would it mean for you to show up in the relationships you do have in your life? What is your next step?
