Think It Over: This section is about turning what God is saying to you into action steps. These talking points, questions, and scriptures are designed to help you take your own next step. If you are leading a group through this guide, don't feel like you have to answer every question. Pick out those questions that will stir up conversation and action among your group.

- For those of us that love eating Chinese food with family and friends, one of the fun aspects is the fortune cookie. When was the last time you got a fun laugh from a fortune cookie? What made it fun? Has one ever been so dead on that you didn't share it with those around you? What is up with that? Some Christians wonder, since reading a fortune implies special prophetic knowledge, whether it is wrong to read fortune cookies. Well, as you can gather from Pastor Dave, for him, he would be overthinking it, if he had a problem with fortunate cookies, yet he doesn't feel the same way about horoscopes. What are some of those practices for you (matters of conscience) that begin to cross the line into what we classified as the occult?
- How does a Christ follower think through "Receive, Reject, Redeem" applying them to something like Halloween or even the Easter Bunny (use Romans 12:2 MSG and the life of Jesus to formulate your answer)? How does Romans 14:22-23 affect your approach when explain your thoughts?
- Have you every thought about the reality that there are only two spiritual forces at work in our world? Why might that seem an over-simplification? How does it help you make sense of the world? Read through the passages following that section. What stands out to you? Why is God so opposed to a person seeking the answers to life in any other place but a connection with the real Him?
- As you listen to the history and practice of Yoga, how has your view on yoga changed or become even more firm? What are some of the other kinds of practices that have a connection to the occult? Why is it important not to open the door to those kinds of influences in your life?
- Read Ephesians 6:12. What is your first impression? Why is the phrase, "our struggle" so important to come to grips with? Do you really believe in 2023 we have to be aware of this struggle? Being aware and scared are two different things. How can you remain aware and not scared (see 1 John 4:4)?
- Read 1 Corinthians 6:12 MSG. While not thinking of others, what could be some things in your life that may be technically okay, but aren't really spiritually appropriate? Have you ever seen someone become owned by the okay in the long run? What happened?

<u>Next Steps</u>: What steps as a Christ follower can you take to avoid becoming personally trapped by things that you think are legally ok, but not spiritually appropriate? How will you live out Ephesians 5:11?
